

Meetings -

Join us Sunday, March 8, 2015 at 1:30 pm, at 1st Jefferson Unitarian Universalist Church for our meeting with Naomi Bennett.

This month we welcome Naomi from Austin, Texas as she presents to us her new and revised view of Hellenistic Astrology. -- Astrology in the 21st century is undergoing a dramatic change as the integration of modern and historical astrology merge into a new working design that is based



on astronomy and the sacred geometry of life. Naomi Bennett looks at astrology's roots and it's underlying structure to unlock the hidden design that was created by ancient civilizations that believed the macrocosm is reflected in the microcosm, that the patterns in the sky are reflected on Earth. All of creation has an underlying geometric structure that is being revealed in modern science and the current discoveries of life's design. Naomi Bennett analyzes these correspondences to tie the hidden geometry of our life events to astrological patterns. She reviews current events with modern techniques to increase the reliability of astrological predictions and she answers the question, has the Age of Aquarius begun? Naomi has practiced astrology since 1970 and is currently president of the Astrological Society of Austin. She teaches astrology as a branch of sacred geometry.




March was named after the god Mars and although it is the 3rd month in the Julian and Gregorian calendars, in the oldest Roman calendar it was the first month of the year. The “Ides of March” were originally determined by the first full moon of the year.




State of the Planets

We have several **planetary event** charts worth noting this month, including the usual **spring equinox** chart. Of added importance, there is the Saturn stationary retrograde, which is on March 14th and is at 4Sag.56, a total Solar Eclipse on March 20th just hours before the equinox, and the very last (!) square between Uranus and Pluto.



Saturn Station Saturn will retrograde back into Scorpio, and then turns direct in August. If Saturn stations in aspect to something in your chart, you may already be feeling his lessons intensely, which usually is no fun!


In this chart make note that Saturn is parallel the moon which is ruled by Saturn, and in detriment. Saturn is ruled by Jupiter, which is hiding out in the moon’s house, and has mutual reception with the Sun, which helps its strength. We can see the last square of Pluto and Uranus which will finally let up on their head-butting after the 17th. As with all retrograde event charts, be mindful of the house cusps for your area, and any of your personal planets/points catching the energy escaping from them.



This year's **spring equinox** has the sun starting his new round in Aries after the moon has already made her appearance with an eclipse marking a potent last blast of Pisces energy before they join volatile Mars and Uranus in Aries. Venus promises favors here in our area, as she is the most dignified, and the most elevated.


