

Expand your astrologer's toolbox with the use of declinations. This data source provides a level of precision to your interpretations that is unavailable using just longitude. Westin will demonstrate the ease and accuracy of using Lifetime Graphs in delineation. She promises a presentation in outline format that is comprehensible to anyone from novice to professional.

Leigh Westin, former editor of the Geocosmic Journal, and current NCGR Director of Chapters, is a noted researcher, author, and lecturer, and a former protégé of Kt Boehrer. During her research, Westin discovered Mars and Venus out-of-bounds in fixed signs and originated the declination premise based on the Earth's dynamics, found the basis of true antiscia, and established the theory of progressed Lunar Seasons TM. Her book, *Beyond the Solstice by Declination*, was cited by *The Mountain Astrologer* for its "wealth of information," naming her a "highly creative astrological thinker." Westin holds multiple accreditations including MS, MA, DFAstrol.S; CA, NCGR.

Leigh wants you to get as much as possible from her talk on Declinations. Since Declinations are somewhat new for some of us, she will be using the Graphic Ephemeris (you have only one for your whole lifetime) to make it easier. President's Message

For a moment, forget all about Uranus square Pluto, square Jupiter, etc. and all the troubles with our weather, the Ukraine, Syria, corruption in the world, and all the other problems. Let's focus on the lighter side of life for once. Wouldn't you like to win the lottery? I know the odds aren't great, but, hey, we're astrologers. After all, somebody is going to win.

With the ASNT talk this month being by one of the authorities of Declinations, Leigh Westin, I was inspired to look at some of my old issues of "The Other Dimension" published by the NCGR Declination SIG. I found the Spring 1999 issue (at that time Leigh was the Editorial Consultant). On p. 9 was an article by Bernard Boyd "Win with your Point-of-Fortune." He writes:

Rule Number One: When the transiting ascendant sign and degree conjuncts the same sign and degree of your Part of Fortune, and the transiting MC is within 30 degrees in either direction of your Natal Moon, you can win! It is as easy as that.

Of course I'm not convinced that it is that easy because I've never won. Maybe it is because I've never tried it yet. Some of you real gamblers might have better luck though, so let's go on.

He writes that there are other combinations too. "If the transiting Point of Fortune conjuncts your natal Sun, Moon, or even Jupiter, this can be lucky. Further when the Sun conjuncts your natal Part of Fortune that whole day is a lucky day."

There are some complications. Though Rule One applies about once every 14 days, it is in effect for only about 2 minutes so "make hay while the sun shines." If you can't get to a place to buy a ticket during the 2 minutes, he says that you can pick your numbers and buy your ticket later. Now that

might work. Actually, I like the sun on the Part of Fortune day better. Mine comes September 14, a Sunday. I'll have to check to see if tickets are sold on Sundays. The last time I tried to buy a lottery ticket at a good time based on some Jupiter transits and a few other things, I got a time of 1:30 am. I stayed up until then only to find out that ticket sales ended earlier. Did I say I'm not really a great gambler?

Boyd claims that whatever you do during these windows will be accompanied by a measure of success – golf, picking horses, throwing darts, making a sale, or entering a competition. One more thing. If you do win, let us know. If it's a big win, thank your Part of Fortune and astrology before you go into hiding to avoid all those NEW friends and lost cousins who are sure to find you.
