
Program: RELATIONSHIP ASTROLOGY-THE ASCENDENT AXIS

Oh, Those Stars!

The Sun entered the sign of Gemini on May 20, 12:06 pm. The Gemini New Moon will be on June 8 at 18 Gemini 01.

The Fort Worth New Moon chart places the New Moon in the eleventh house and unaspected. You may find yourself being more social and scattered this month. And you may be more mentally active and able to be more emotionally detached.

Mercury Venus and Jupiter are all in the eleventh along with the Sun Moon conjunction. Dane Rudhyar called the eleventh house the most shining house in the chart, and considered it to be the house of seeding the future after the culmination at the midheaven. The major configuration in the chart is a Cardinal T-square featuring Pluto in the fifth, opposing Mercury in the eleventh and both squaring Uranus in the ninth house. Be careful how you communicate especially in groups, as communications are subject to being blown out of proportion and may cause unexpected results.

Alternately, it can bring situations and events that utterly transform your ideas and thinking. This will be especially true if you have any planets or sensitive points at 10-11 degrees cardinal in your chart.
