President's Corner

By this time next month, September 7 and 8, we will be hearing Chris Brannan talking to us about Hellenistic Astrology. Project Hindsight, which started in 1993 by Robert Hand, Robert Schmidt and others to translate the surviving texts of the Western tradition into English, started working with both Medieval and Hellenistic Astrology. They soon discovered, though, that the defining core of Medieval Astrology was derived from Hellenistic sources. This is what they focused on then, and this is what is taught at Kepler College where Chris Brannan got his degree.

Our Western Astrology comes from this System of Hermes (from Hermes Trismegistus, the founder of the Hellenistic tradition). We used to believe that astrology developed over many years from observations

and correlations with celestial phenomena. New concepts and techniques were added and those that did not “work” were discarded. However, this view does not hold up under historical scrutiny.

Most core concepts and techniques that we use today come from this System of Hermes, yet about half of the original ones had been lost. By now, Project Hindsight has rediscovered many of them, and this is what Chris will be teaching us.

For example, we are familiar with “applying and separating” aspects, but do we know about “testimony, hurling of rays, superior position, containment (or besiegement) or spear bearing”? Do we know about “sect, rejoicing conditions, corruption and bonification, or ages associated with houses”?

Hellenistic astrology is not new to us, but we just don't have the complete picture yet.
